Tips for Enrolling Younger Students

- 1. **Use a Lighter Touch -** Smaller fingers need a lighter touch during enrollment.
- 2. **Guide Enrollment Placements** Place the student fingers to ensure proper finger placement because younger students may lack the finer motor skills.



Tips for identifying Younger Students

- 1. **Practice, Practice -** Since younger students are still developing their fine motor skills they need to practice their finger scans.
- 2. **Change Sounds** Changing the positive ID sounds regularly helps keep children focused and engaged.



- 3. **Have Patience** At first, your younger students may need a second or third try getting the proper finger placement. Be patient. They will learn to do this quickly.
- 4. **Give a Target** Sometimes pointing to where the younger students where to place their fingers helps. Some people use stickers (just don't place it on the scanner glass).
